

ENVIRONMENT SUSTAINABILITY STATEMENT



At Club on East, we recognise our responsibility to operate in a manner that is environmentally sustainable and socially responsible. As a community focused venue, we are committed to minimising our environmental footprint while continuing to provide exceptional service and experiences for our members, guests and the community.

To meet this commitment, we have implemented a wide range of initiatives across waste reduction, environmental sustainability and social engagement. These actions reflect our proactive approach to sustainability and our dedication to continuous improvement.

01 WASTE REDUCTION

Minimising waste at the source is a top priority for Club on East. We prioritise the reduce, reuse, and recycle system to minimise waste in landfills and protect the local environment.

Our current efforts include:

- Maintaining a general recycling system to responsibly manage recyclable materials.
- Composting organic wastes such as coffee grounds, fruit scraps and paper cups and straws.
- Using digital screens throughout the Club for advertising and communication to significantly reduce paper use.
- Replacing disposable paper towels with reuseable, washable cloths to cut down on single-use waste behind the bar.
- Implementing a First-In-First-Out (FIFO) stock rotation system to reduce food and beverage waste from expired products.
- Using paper straws in place of plastic alternatives to reduce single-use plastic waste.
- Participating in the 10c container return scheme to encourage recycling and reduce waste.



02 ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY

We're also committed to preserving and improving the natural environment within and around the Club through various measures, including:

- Introducing indoor greenery and plants throughout the venue to improve air quality and create a more environmentally conscious atmosphere.
- Upgrading to LED energy efficient light bulbs to lower electricity use.
- Using energy efficient washing machines to reduce water and power usage.
- Avoiding the use of clothes dryers by drying all laundered items on clotheslines.
- Reducing unnecessary power consumption by ensuring lights and equipment are turned off when not in use.

03 SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Sustainability at Club on East also means positively engaging with our staff, members and the community. We continue to:

- Support local sporting clubs and community groups through sponsorships, donations, and contributions.
- Engage staff by keeping them informed of ongoing environmental initiatives and encouraging participation and feedback.
